Upgradation of MGSU Library: Implementing RFID Technology for Enhanced Digitization and Accessibility (24 May 2024)

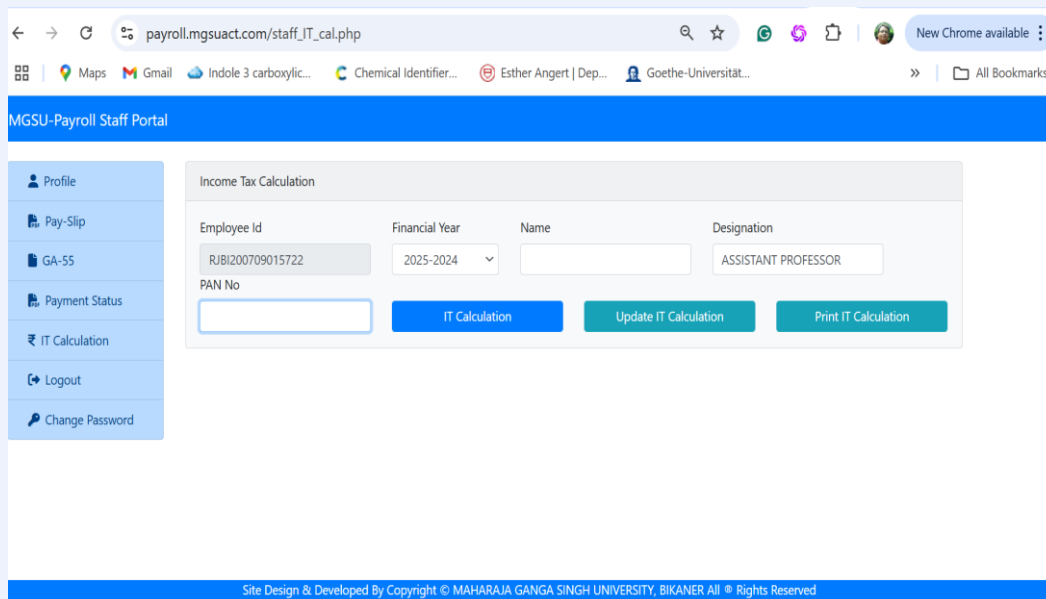

Extension activities leading to community development (Adopted Village, Swaroopdesar)

Maharaja Ganga Singh University's has conducted various activities under its social responsibility initiative in the adopted village of Swaroopdesar in 2023-2024. These activities include discussions on pond desilting, tree plantation drives, and computer training programs aimed at enhancing education and environmental awareness. Notably, the university donated indoor patient beds to the primary health center in September 2023, significantly improving local healthcare facilities. The NSS also organized cleanliness drives, a voter awareness campaign, and adult education programs to empower the community. In February 2024, a cleanliness drive at Amrit Sarovar and a drug awareness rally further demonstrated the university's commitment to promoting health and well-being. Additionally, the university facilitated visits for local school students to inspire them about higher education opportunities. Under the guidance of Vice-Chancellor Prof. Manoj Dixit, Maharaja Ganga Singh University has made significant contributions to the adopted village of Swaroopdesar through its social responsibility initiatives. Dr. Prabhu Daan Charan, the village in-charge (Ex.), presented indoor patient beds to the local health center, a gesture that was well-received by the community, which expressed gratitude to Prof. Dixit and the Registrar for enhancing healthcare facilities. The National Service Scheme (NSS) conducted a Health and Hygiene Campaign to promote sanitation and overall well-being among villagers. Throughout the year, Vice-Chancellor Acharya Manoj Dixit visited Swaroopdesar multiple times to discuss development plans with local leaders, including Sarpanch Udar Ram Meghwal, Village Development Officer Abhishek Upadhyay, and Kishanaram Siyag. During these visits, he addressed community issues and proposed an action plan focusing on health and education improvements. This plan included establishing a library in the village and organizing health awareness camps for women and children to prevent diseases. The villagers requested technical and financial support for these initiatives, reinforcing the university's commitment to community development and proactive engagement in addressing local needs. Current in-charges Dr. Santosh Shekhawat and Dr. Umesh Sharma (NSS) also emphasized the university's dedication to fostering positive change in the community.
